



Do 5 HIGH JUMPS

Clue: If you are tired, you can sit on me for a rest



Do 5 SQUATS

Clue: I can get very hot, and cook lovely tasty food for you.



Do 5 JUMPING JACKS

Clue: I can be hot or cold, turn me on to make me wet



Do 5 HEEL FLICKS

Clue: I can talk, sing, and even make you dance





Do 5 TOE TOUCHES

Clue: You can hang things on me to help them dry



Clue: I am soft, and cuddly, and give great hugs



Do 5 PRESS UPS

Clue: I mind all your toys when you are not here



Do 5 SIT UPS

Clue: I mind what you wear, clean or dirty





Clue: Keep me open or close me, I will let you in and out



Clue: I am one of many on your house. Look in and look out



Clue: Zzzz, sleep tight



Answers

Tips for setting up the Active Treasure Hunt

- The 1st clue is read out at the starting point.
- Depending on your outdoor area, mix up the clues and place them in locations whereby the children have to walk/ run a good distance before reaching the next point.
- If you have plastic sheets/small sandwich bags/ laminating sheets, place each clue on one, so you can re-use them.
- If a few siblings are doing the hunt together, and some are older/ faster set a rule that the group must stay together throughout the hunt, complete the exercises together, and figure out the next clue together, before moving on.
- Attach each clue with a little tape, so they don't blow away
- You choose the 'Treasure' to be found at the last location. Although more often than not, the prize is sweet treats, other options could include:
 - They get to choose a movie to watch
 - Staying up a little bit later at bedtime
 - Extra playtime
 - Pick their favourite dinner for tomorrow
 - One day of 'jobs'
